Bylaw #538-18 ADVERTISING BYLAW - EXCERPTS

Any notice required to be advertised under section 606 of the Municipal Government Act of a bylaw, resolution, meeting, public hearing or other thing may be given in accordance with the timelines prescribed in Section 606 by all of the following means:

- (1) electronically by posting the notice prominently on the Village of Vilna official website. <u>Vilna.ca</u>

POLICY #109-18 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION POLICY - EXCERPTS Purpose:

Public input is essential to the municipal decision making process. Council believes it is advantageous to identify the levels and process of communication and citizen engagement prior to making certain levels of decisions. Additionally, it is incumbent upon the public to participate and to share ideas, concerns, requests or needs to Council.

The legalization of cannabis in Canada is going to have an effect on everyone. Each of us has a different viewpoint on this issue, but as a municipality there are decisions that will have to be made regarding the public use of, sale of, and growth of the product.

Some of the questions Council will be considering at the next Council meeting will include:

- 1. Should cannabis be sold in Vilna?
 - If yes, should there be limitations on the location of the retail site?
 - Such as distance to schools or health facilities?
 - What hours should sales be allowed?
- 2. Should people be allowed to smoke cannabis in public?
 - If yes, where?
- 3. Should Council permit the growth of cannabis within the Village?

A Bylaw regulating public use of cannabis will be presented at the next Council meeting Sept. 17, 2018 at 7pm.

A new committee has been struck for Council – the Inter-Municipal Collaboration Framework Committee, working with municipalities in the Smoky Lake Region. This is a requirement of provincial Municipal Government Act Part 17.2 and Regulation #191/2017,

Sewer flushing was recently completed in the Village to help identify problems before they are emergency repairs. Funding for this project was obtained through a grant.

Sewer Lift Station

The Sewer Lift Station Project is 98% complete. New pumps have been installed as well as an electronic system that will notify the staff if there is a malfunction or power failure. Also installed is a new generator that will automatically switch on if there is a power failure.

Garbage and Recycle (cardboard, metals, compost (separated)) pickup is on <u>Wednesdays</u> - Items for pickup should be out for 8am.

If you have a dog, you require a license (\$10/year per dog at the Village office). Dogs must be on a leash when off your property.

If you have or are starting a business you require a business license – \$10 at the Village office.

PLEASE ensure you maintain your yard (summer) and sidewalks (winter)

Vilna Transfer Station (dump) is west about a mile west on the north village boundary road #594. It accepts household garbage, cardboard, garden waste, trees/trimmings, unpainted untreated wood, some household hazardous waste containers, batteries, tires etc. NO Building materials are permitted.
